2. Financial Report from August 17, 2010 to December 10, 2010 was reviewed. Lee Ralphs moved and Dave Ross seconded a motion to accept the report. Vote was unanimous.

1. IHSAA Board of Directors -Barbara Taylor
  - United Dairymen have significantly increased their donation to IHSAA Activities
  - Representation went out on the first reading.
  - Classification proposals are due by Jan 15
  - National Federation is sponsoring a parent education
  - Non varsity officials used at varsity level. If needed in an emergency contact IHSAA for approval
  - Transfer rule for divorced or separated parents- must have a legal decree for student transfers.
  - IHSAA current Trophy contract is open for bids

- Request by the 4A/5A Basketball programs to use 3 man crews at state basketball is being considered. Would increase costs.
  - Volleyball Tournament single elimination was not supported by coaches but will continue in a 2 year rotation.
2. Dance/Drill - Julie Green
    - District Competition is Saturday, February 12 at Pocatello High School
  3. 2A Administrators -John Cockett-
    - District Tournaments will primarily be hosted by the League winners
  4. 5A Administrators - Dave Ross- Football Schedule
    - Filling a Football schedule has become more difficult
  5. Cheer - Shari Bradley
    - Cheer Squads cannot stunt or tumble during a 30 sec basketball time out.
    - Schools can register on line for District Dance/Drill and Cheer Competition
  6. Music -DeAnne Casperson
    - Fall Music Clinic was a success.
    - Music Fees – All schools pay \$335 in the fall assessment. However, at the Fall Clinic schools pay per student involved to equalize fees.
  7. Speech Arts -Kaileen Harris
    - District and State Drama have been completed
    - District Schools placed well at State
  8. 4A Administrator - Robert Parker
    - Excessive physical play in the key is a concern in Basketball
  9. 1A Administrator -Dan Ralphs
    - 1A Schools are concerned about incidents at ShoBan at both the High School and Junior High level.
  10. Officials Association -Gerald Christensen
    - More officials are being retained
    - Rough physical play in Basketball will be discussed with Basketball commissioner
  11. Coaches of Boys Sports - Lee Ralphs-
    - The coaches association sent flowers to the funeral of Greg Berholm's wife.
    - Idaho Coaches Association Coaches Clinic is scheduled for July 17-19 possibly Jackpot. Our district has had poor attendance. We need to promote the clinic.
  12. Coaches of Girls Sports -Shauna Mathews

- The position of 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President in the Idaho Coaches Association is open. A candidate from our area is needed.

13. IHSAA President/Secretary Meeting –Gary Brogan

- Football Play-off Sites Approval forms- Schools are to fill out the forms and specify where they do not meet the recommended standards.

16. Commissioners Reports

➤ Soccer – Sam Knighton

- Used Arbiter second year and local soccer program has paid for its use.
- Fields are improving.
- Six Fifth District Soccer Officials worked the State Soccer Tournaments.

➤ Football - Ren Edwards

- Used on line registration and certification on the internet for the first time this year
- Had a number of changes in the schedules dates, sites, times but still had officials to all the games even on short notice
- Registered 61 officials this year, the most the Fifth District has had
- Post season many Fifth District officials worked contests
- See many games, observe the officials, teaches on the field, at half time and after games.

➤ Volleyball –Jean Paskins

- Number of officials has increased slightly this year
- Problems encountered this year
  - Not getting schedules back from schools by Aug 1
  - Schedules are not on proper form nor do they indicate number of officials need or number of nets to be used.
  - Ad's are not checking their schedules on the Arbiter to see if they are correct

- Schools and Ad's are sending assigned officials home without consulting her
- Items that need to be address for next year
  - Guidelines for schools canceling officials,
  - Schedules turned in by realistic date- May 1
  - Fines if no schedule sent
  - Fines for late changes by schools and officials
