#### Consent Agenda

1. Minutes of January 4, 2005 were reviewed. The board voted unanimously to accept them.
2. Minutes of March 8, 2005 were reviewed. The board voted unanimously to accept them.

#### Report Agenda

1. IHSAA Report- Don Cotant The IHSAA Board of Control's fall meeting will be held in the 6<sup>th</sup> District. District 5 needs to be sure to be well represented. Football practice regulations will probably be approved. School classification and division of classification is always an issue. Schools petitioning down in classification is a problem to all school. The board voted to write a letter as a board stating their objections to schools petitioning down in classification as it eventually involves all school adversely. Coaches' First Aid certification is mandatory for the fall of 2005. Making eligibility requirements for Dance/Drill and Cheer equal to those for competitive sports in being looked at.
2. Coaches of Girls Sports – Launa Moser The Fifth District has increased their membership in the Idaho Coaches Association above that of last year. Nominations for Idaho Coaches awards in all areas are needed.
3. Coaches of Boys Sports - Lee Ralphs Coaches of Boys Basketball voted unanimously to change the due date of their officials ballot. They want it due near the end of their season when they have played the majority of their games. Coaches of Girls and Boys Basketball unanimously voted to have the highest ranked officials sent to the state tournaments rather than making officials choose which tournament they will work.
4. Speech Arts – Tamara Christensen The Debate Protocol was reviewed at the March 8, 2005 delegate assembly and is ready to be added to the Fifth District Handbook. The District Speech Tournament is being hosted by Pocatello High School.
5. Dance/Drill – Shari Bradley The District Dance/Drill meet was very successful. Next year's meet is scheduled and will be held at Pocatello High School.
6. Cheer – Irene Alder The District Cheer meet went well and was financially very successful. Some of the proceeds from the meet will be used to help those teams who will be attending the State Invitation Cheer Tournament in Boise.
7. 5A – Dave Ross –5A Basketball coaches would like to see the vote by classifications used to help make the assignments for officials for the next season, so they would receive the officials they voted for during the regular season.
8. Music – Ralph Bennett The recent Honors Festival was a success.
9. Sport Commissioners – Ren Edwards will be the Football Commissioner and Roger Kunz will be the Basketball Commissioner.
10. 1A – Dan Ralphs – Basketball Proposal to go to 5 Quarters or 100 Quarters for 20 Games. Don Cotant will take to the State Board of Control.

#### Report Agenda

1. Commissioner Job Description- Revisions of a Sport Commissioner job description were reviewed and revisions made. This item will move to the action agenda in the May meeting.
2. Appeal Process/Standing Committee – Gary Brogan presented the committees proposal. It was review, revised, and will move to the action agenda in the May meeting.

3. Travel/Mileage- suggestions made by this committee were reviewed. Rather than place them in the handbook, the board felt they should be given to the sport commissioners as suggested guidelines.
4. Appeals by Malad High School and Soda Springs High School in Girls Basketball were denied by the Board.

#### Discussion Agenda

1. Ren Edwards, Football Commissioner, met with the Board discussing his plans and the boards expectations. Ren will also serve as the Football Rules interpreter.
2. North Gem High School letter of appeal on a music violation was reviewed. The board voted to rescind \$25 of the violation, leaving a balance of \$50.
3. Web Master- The board thanked John Gist for his service to the Activity Association on the Fifth District Web site. The board approved having the District Secretary pursue a new Web Master.
4. Tie Break Procedure was moved to the Action Agenda for the May Meeting.
5. Commissioners will be in charge of getting digital pictures of officials in their sports to the District Secretary in a timely manner to be put on the web site to aid coaches in voting on the official's ballots.

#### Action Agenda

1. Ineligible Player Participation in District Girls Basketball Tournament. The Board voted to fine Marsh Valley High School \$300 and to place the Girls Basketball program on probation for one year.
2. Debate Protocol- The Board vote to place the Debate Protocol in the Fifth District Handbook.
3. American Falls Eligibility Violation Appeal. The Board denied the appeal. American Falls is fine \$75 for the violation.
4. Commissioner Salaries for Football and Volleyball were increased to \$1,000.
